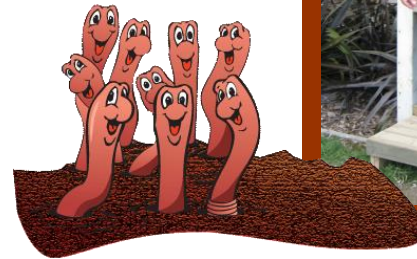
The New Step
