REMINDERS for TERM 4:

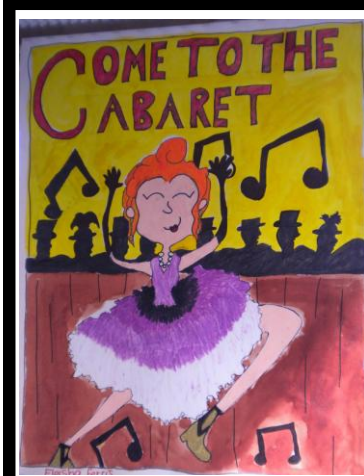
- **HATS**
Hats are compulsory in term 4 and in term 1 (our summer terms). Please ensure that your child has a SCHOOL sunhat to wear – these are available from the school office for \$12.40
- **CARS AT SCHOOL**
 - We have a continuing problem with cars in the drive through before and after school. Please remember that we are a TRAVELWISE school and as such encourage students to walk, bike or skateboard/scooter at least part of the way to school. This relieves congestion at the school as well as helping with carbon emissions.
 - We are REQUIRED to allow free and safe BUS ACCESS to our school and this last term, this has been a problem with cars parking in the drop off zone and clogging the driveway, restricting access to the buses. If this continues in term 4, I will have no option but to stop car access to the drive through completely, so please help us by NOT PARKING there and by NOT STOPPING if the bus is due or already in the driveway.

PLEASE DROP OFF AND DRIVE ON IN THE MORNINGS – do not stop and leave your car, or spend time doing children's hair or packing their school bags in the car. Buses arrive between 8am and 9am, so you need to be aware of this throughout this time and keep the area free.

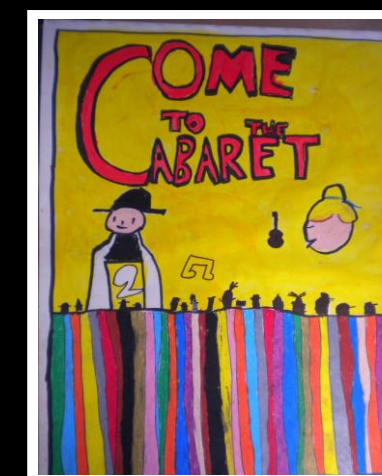
