School News

Buses

Bus No.8 travels from Sandspit to Snells Beach School and back. Children who live on the northern side of James Street are entitled to catch this bus, but we are fortunate to have an arrangement with Gubbs Motors and the transport network that allows children who do not have a funding entitlement on the route to school to also catch this bus. Please be advised that this arrangement may be subject to change during the year. The bus leaves the bottom of Brick Bay Drive at 7.50am and will pick students up in the morning at the stop at the top of Governor Grey and Tamatea Rds and in the afternoon will stop ONLY at the corner of Muncaster Rd.

The afternoon bus leaves school at 3pm.

Bus No.11 travels from Martins Bay/Scotts Landing to Snells Beach School and back. We have been very fortunate this year to secure a dedicated bus in the afternoons for this run and our children no longer have to wait for the College bus at 3.40pm. Consequently this bus will now leave school at 3pm.

Children who live down Ridge Rd or Martins Bay past the intersection with Ridge Rd are entitled to catch this bus. As with Bus 8, we have an arrangement for children who do not have funding entitlements from Algies Bay to catch this bus. Please be advised that this arrangement may be subject to change during the year. The bus will pick up/drop off Algies Bay students at the bus stop on Mahurangi East Rd only.

Bus 11 leaves Charles Street at 7.50am and Scandrett Regional Park entrance at 8am.

If you would like you child to catch the us you must complete a Bus Transport Form so that we know when your child will be travelling, for safety reasons. These are available from Miss Henry in the office.

Safety in the School Grounds, Carparks and Drive-Through

Our primary concern is to keep students and adults in our school safe. We need to have a few rules to ensure that people do this and we will enforce these. We would appreciate your help and co-operation.

Cars – if you are driving to/from school please:

- Observe the mandatory 40km per hour speed limit around the school on Dawson Rd and where children cross on Mahurangi East Road.
- **Stop at the crossing** when children are waiting to cross.
- **Do not park in the staff carpark** as children have to cross the driveway there and it is not patrolled, so they are not looking for cars coming in and out.

- **Do not park in the drive through** before school or until the buses have gone after school. We now have two buses parking and leaving together just after 3pm and there is not enough room to cope with cars and children getting into cars in the drive through at the same time. The buses will be gone by 3.05pm please respect this and wait until then to drive through and/or park and pick up your child/ren. Thank you.
- There is parking available in the visitor parks opposite and to the side of the office out the front of the school otherwise please park on the road in the mornings or the afternoons if you wish to leave your car and walk into the school grounds.
- We have a policy of encouraging walking, biking, scootering and skateboading to school and we have racks available for children to use for their equipment. Please help us by encouraging your child to came to school a Travelwise way.

Other safety routines:

We regularly practice other safety routines such as fire evacuations, volcanic eruption routines and armed offender routines. Some of these are planned and some are not. Teachers will be talking to students about these routines and why we do them.

Homework Club & After School Activities

This year, Tony and Michelle Mordaunt, through their company – *Make a Difference Through Sport*, will be running our homework club and providing after school activities. A separate notice about this came home with students this week – if you need another copy, please refer to our website or ask at the office. There will be a charge for both activities – homework sessions and the follow on activities. Children can be booked in to one or both.

These sessions will operate out of Puriri 2 from 3pm.

We are very grateful for this service as it provides a cost-effective after school option for parents. This has come after a trial of options following the closure of the SKIDS after school programme. This is significantly cheaper and will be run in line with our school philosophies and practices. Please support this useful new initiative.
