Welcome to our 'new look' school newsletter. This is the first step in our transition to a full e-newsletter, available mainly online in due course. We have no plans to move to that immediately, but we hope this format will make it easier to access information both online and in hard copy.

Term 1 passed in a blur and it was a busy one with a number of milestones reached. Significant to that was the visit from the Education Review Office in the second-to-last week of the term. We do not have the draft report as yet (it is expected in a few weeks), but the Board and I were very pleased and proud of the verbal feedback we received from the ERO team at the last Board meeting of the term. They captured the spirit and ethos of the school and told us that we do an exceptional job of caring for and educating students in a holistic way. They praised the governance and leadership of the school, as well as the teachers, who they commended for implementing strong programmes and doing an excellent job of encouraging student-led inquiry. They said our partnership with Ngati Wai and the work we were doing to create strong partnerships was 'second to none' and they went away to write this aspect up as a case study for their ERO colleagues. The feedback was indeed affirmation that the hard work completed in the last 3 years, since the first ERO review of the school, has been recognized and rewarded.

We were commended by ERO for our annual plan and focus for this year, as well as for our collaborative Vision on which this is based. A copy of the school's collaborative Vision Statement – developed by the board of Trustees, the Teachers, the PTA and other invited parents in 2012 is reproduced on Pages 2 & 3, along with the Vision Streams that form our development Plan until 2018. We thought this was a good time to outline this for you.

Welcome to the new families who have joined us this term. We hope you will enjoy being part of our school. Enjoy the term ahead everyone!
