

Section 1 Spring Bulbs

- 1 Freesia 1 single
- 2 Freesia 1 double
- 3 Freesia 3 different
- 4 Iris 1 (1 bud allowed)
- 5 Daffodil 1 single
- 6 Daffodil 3 different
- 7 Daffodils A vase mixed
- 8 Bulb/Corms 3 cut flowers, any variety

Section 2 Flowers Garden Variety

- 9 Pansy/hybrid 3 blooms saucer supplied
- 10 Viola 3 blooms saucer supplied
- 11 Multiple Head 1 stem
- 12 Daisies 3 single stems, mixed or any variety
- 13 Annual 1 stem
- 14 Perennial 1 stem (No green goddess arum lily)
- 15 Mixed Cut Flowers in own vase
- 16 Orchid 1 stem – in own vase

Section 3 Creative

This is the only section which allows purchased flowers, foliage and accessories

- 17 A Design with a Candle Novice
(A novice is an entrant who has won first prize less than 3 times)
- 18 Stepping Out - not more than 45cm Open
- 19 Baby Shower Design – maximum 30cm Open
- 20 Spring Carnival – not more than 45cm wide Open
- 21 Woodland Wonders Open

Section 4 Camellias

- 22 Small – up to 8 cm
- 23 Medium – 8–10 cm
- 24 Large – over 10 cm
- 25 3 in own floating bowl, any variety, no greenery
- 26 3 same variety on own plate, no greenery

Section 5 Open

- 27 Outstanding Miniature Flower – own vase
- 28 Flowering Shrub – one kind
- 29 A collection of flaxes – 1 vase
- 30 Foliage – 3 distinct kinds – 1 vase
- 31 A potted Bromeliad
- 32 A collection of potted Succulents/Cactus – 1 pot
- 33 A pot to be judged on foliage
- 34 1 Pot plant/s – flowering, mixed or same variety
- 35 Pot of Flowering Bulbs

Section 6 Fruit and vegetables use own containers

- 36 3 Lemons – any variety
- 37 3 vegetables – any variety
- 38 3 stalks of rhubarb
- 39 a vase of Herbs

Section 7 Children (please provide own container)

- 40 An arrangement in a saucer 5 years & under *Write your name*
- 41 An arrangement in a saucer 6-8 years *under entry*
- 42 A dish garden 9-12 years

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Exhibits must have been property of exhibitor for 2 months, excluding Creative Section 3 which allows purchased flowers, foliage, fruit, vegetables and accessories if desired (but not artificial flowers).

Exhibitor to stage entries in container supplied.

Exceptions: Section 2:15, 2:16, Creative section 3, Section 4:25, 4:26, Pot Plants section 5, 5:27, Fruit & vegetables Section 6, Children's section 7

Exhibitor to position flowers to face Judges.

Exhibitor to empty water and packing materials from supplied containers, and remove exhibits at close of Show.
