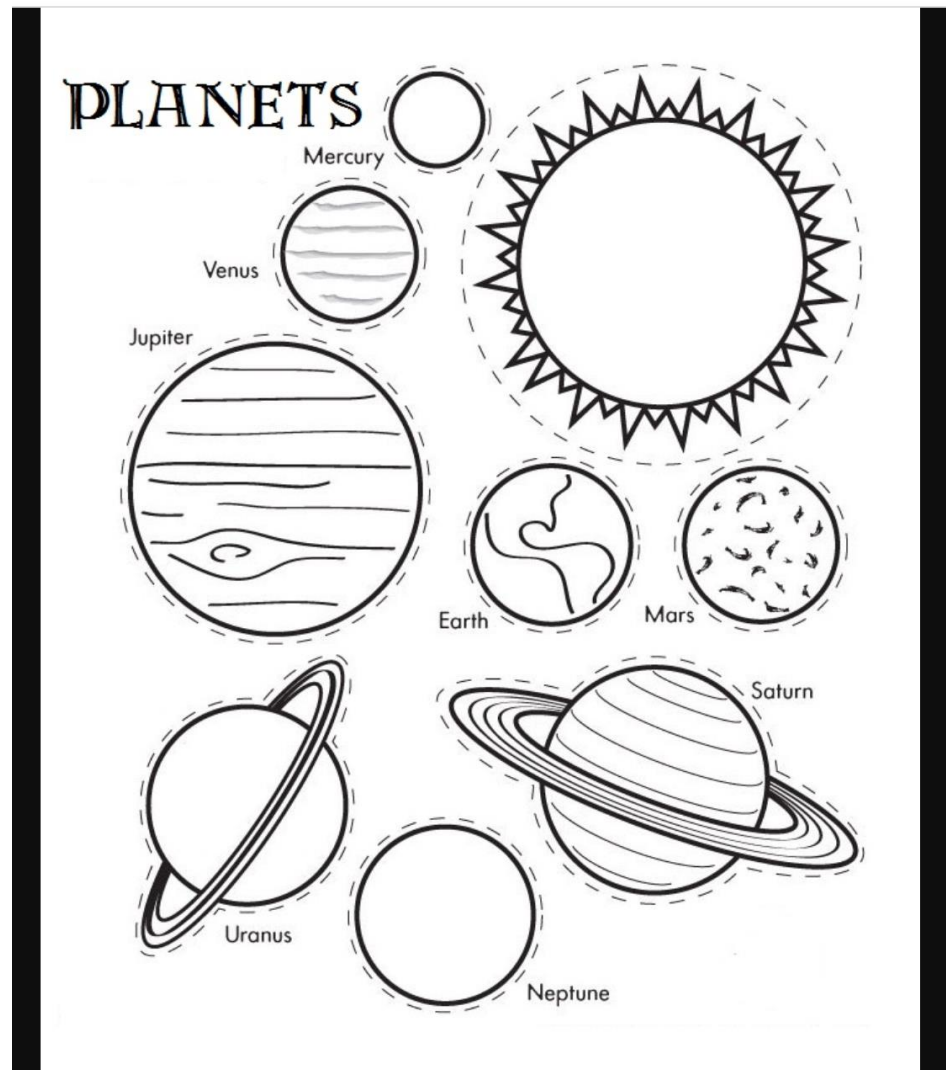

Make some Moon and Asteroid cookies!

## Moon and asteroid cookies











Makes about 12 cookies

### Ingredients:

-  125g butter (softened) or margarine
-  75g caster sugar
-  200g self raising flour
-  1 egg
-  1 tsp vanilla extract
-  10g cocoa powder
-  50g white chocolate chips
-  50g sugar coated chocolates



### Method:

-  1. Preheat your oven to 180 (fan 160) or gas mark 4 and line two baking trays with non-stick baking paper
-  2. In a clean bowl, add the sugar to the butter and cream together with a wooden spoon until light in colour and fluffy.
-  3. Beat in the egg and vanilla extract.
-  4. Sift in the flour and beat into the mixture.
-  5. Divide the mixture in half and put into two separate bowls.
-  6. To one half of the mixture, add the white chocolate chips and mix in well.
-  7. To the other half of the mixture, beat in the cocoa powder, then stir in the sugar coated chocolates until well mixed.
-  8. Drop rounded tablespoon sized dollops of the dough onto the baking sheets, shaping them into round discs and spacing well apart.
-  9. Bake until golden in colour which should be between 8 and 10 minutes.
-  10. Allow to cool slightly before transferring to a cooling rack.

**These are best eaten the day they are made, especially if they're still warm!**

**Always ask an adult for help when using the oven.**

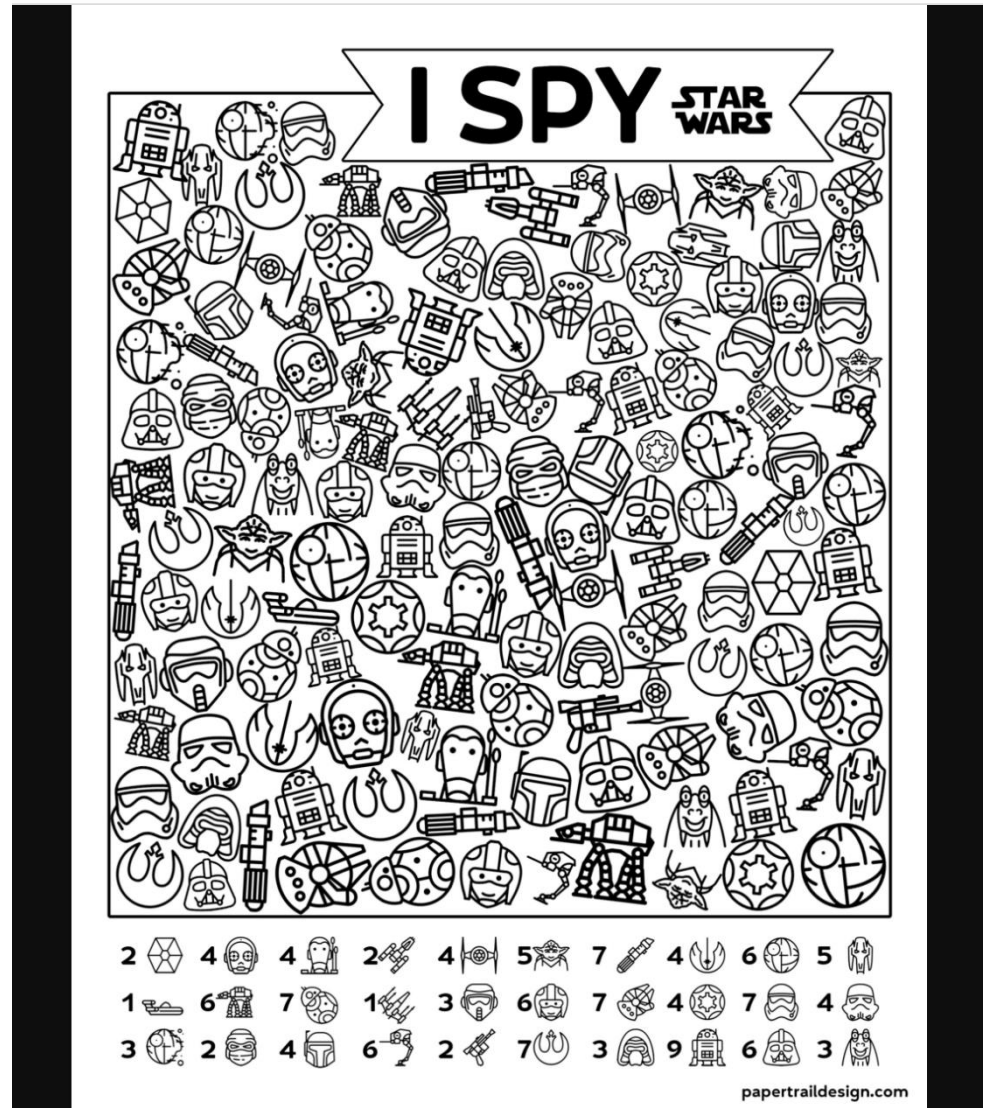

<p>Afternoon</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Play Maths Game: Make 10 Circus</b></p> <p>Purpose:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● To practice groupings within 10.</li> </ul> <p>You need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <a href="#">Game board</a> (PDF, 492KB)</li> <li>● 1 - 10 dice or spinner</li> <li>● 5 counters per player (Each player needs their own colour. You could also use green and blue milk bottle tops.)</li> <li>● 10 peanuts (counters, walnut shells, plastic beans)</li> <li>● Two players</li> </ul>
	<p>How to play:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Each player has a turn to throw the dice or spin the spinner.</li> <li>● For each number they throw/spin they have to say how many more they would need to make 10. For example, if they threw a 6 they would say 6 and 4 more makes 10.</li> <li>● If the 4 is not covered on the circus game board they are allowed to cover it with their coloured counter. If the 4 is already covered they miss a turn and pass the dice to the next player.</li> <li>● Once all the numbers are covered the player with the most counters on the board is allowed one peanut.</li> <li>● The game starts again.</li> <li>● The winner is the first player to collect 5 peanuts.</li> </ul>
