

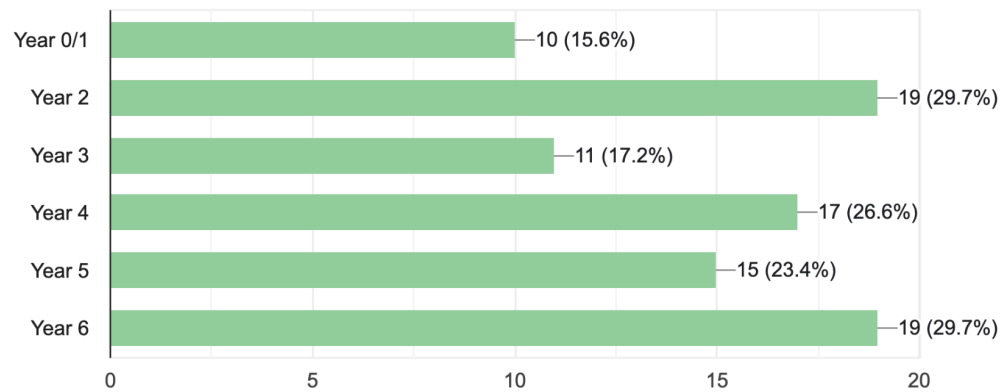

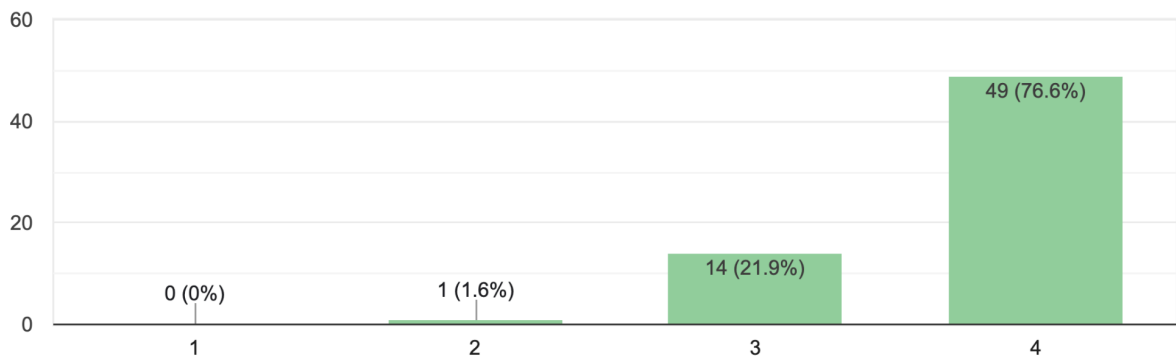
Question 1 : What year level is your child/children?

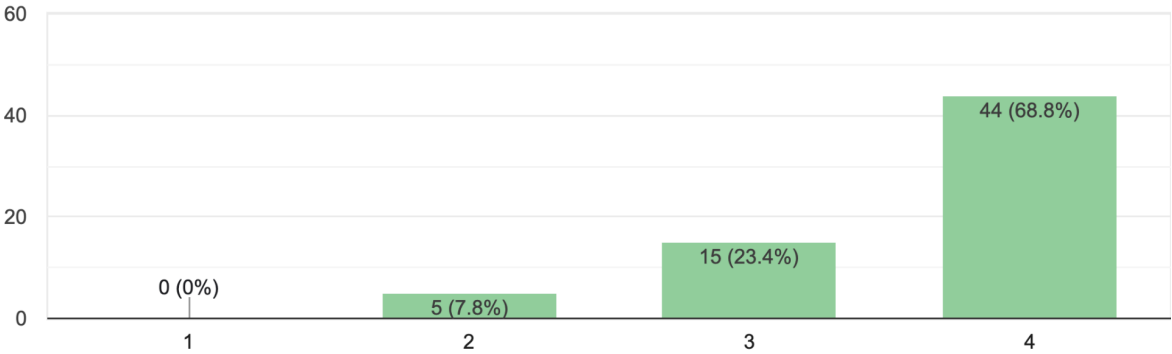

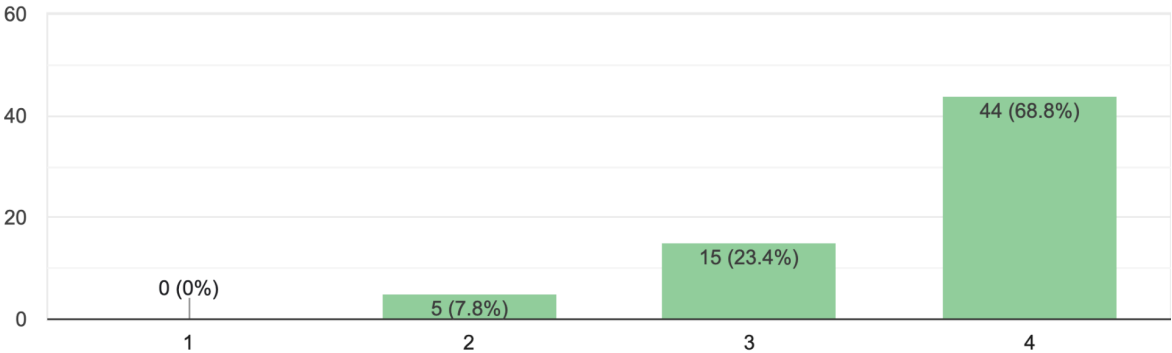
