

## Snells Beach School Out of Zone Enrolment Information



Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office or on our website. The board has determined that limited places may be available for out of zone students for 2027 (starting from Term 1) for Year 1, 2 and 3 only. The exact number of places per year level will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment in these terms the following dates apply:

- application closing date – Wednesday 14 October 2026
- ballot date – Wednesday 21 October 2026.

Applications must be made on the official Out of Zone Application form and must be emailed to the Snells Beach School Office Manager, Marissa Bale on [mbale@snellsbeach.school.nz](mailto:mbale@snellsbeach.school.nz)

Applications from out of zone students will be processed in the following order or priority:

- First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in an approved special programme run by the school. Our school has no such programme
- Second priority must be given to any applicant who is a sibling of current student of the school
- Third priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- Fourth priority must be given to applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- Fifth priority must be given to applicant who is the child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants

If the number of out of zone applicants exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out of zone places is required it will be held on 21st October 2026. Parents will be informed by email of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

Students who are unsuccessful are put on a waiting list in the order they were drawn in the ballot. They may be offered a place if it becomes available later in the year. The waiting list remains until the school holds its next ballot.
